Call to Order/Welcome

Mayor Brown called the meeting of the Transportation and Infrastructure Planning Committee to order at 9:00 a.m.

Critical Infrastructure Needs

Amy Tracy, Dewberry Engineers, spoke regarding funding opportunities for Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade Project. She stated that it is important for the City to know that grant money can only happen when we show that we have local dollars to be able to compete for it. The City has to be able to show that the City has dollars that are dedicated here locally because the provider of the funding needs to have some assurance that the City is going to complete the project that they have allocated the dollars for.

Brian Icerman, Jones Edmonds, provided a draft report of the master plan or strategic plan for the City. He reported that the report was done from not just what the City needs but also what the State of Florida asks for. Mr. Icerman stated that his firm had identified 55 drainage issues throughout the City. He recommended that the City use the list to identify projects to implement and funding sources.

Mayor Brown proposed a workshop on the list and getting a game plan. The consultants would also be invited.

City Manager Stefen Wynn advises that this is a true CIP plan. A workshop would be the best way to coordinate for the 5, 10 or 15 year plan.
