**Old Business**

**Jarboe Park Update**

Colin Moore, Grant and Resiliency Coordinator, explained there was a grant amendment geared toward Phase 1A, the multi-use trail that is part of the East Coast Greenway and the main entrance bridge in front of the Neptune House. The CIP sheets for this fiscal year and the next fiscal year have been updated. The total costs have been broken down over two fiscal years as there is a timeline for the grants. The playground equipment is included. Some of the adult fitness equipment has been taken out, but more equipment for children has been added.

Chairman Messinger stated that the City's Public Works Department would be utilized for a vast majority of the site work. He added that City staff will be working closely with contractors and engineers.

City Manager Wynn explained there will be a draft of the plan at the July Finance Committee meeting for review.

Discussion ensued regarding landscaping, the pavilion, and the youth basketball court. There are still moving parts with this phasing. The next thing that will happen is a review at the July 15 Finance Committee meeting, then the July 20 City Council workshop, then final approval on August 3.
