1. Call to Order
2. Old Business
 - a. Tree Policy Updates for Dover Kohl

Ms. Wright explained she and Mr. Raiti of the CBD had been working on a draft that could be ready in December.
 - b. Tree Planting-Beautification Committee

Chris Chin, president of the Beautification Committee, reported that public works is in the process of locating utilities. Addresses have been identified for trees.
 - c. Duval Tree Mitigation Fund Tree Planting – Jarboe Park

Colin Moore reported there were delays in the court lighting. We would like the main sidewalk and more construction completed before finalizing the tree plantings with COJ.
 - d. Beach Recycling, Container Improvements and Educational Signs (Better, Cheaper, Faster)

Discussion surrounded improving the garbage containers at the beach accesses. Mr. Wynn stated that materials are becoming increasingly more expensive. It would be cost prohibitive to do them all at once. We can look at supplemental funding.
3. New Business
 - a. Wayfinding & Signage and Street Sign Updates(consistency)

The City is looking at updating signage and replacing stop signs that have gotten old. We also need to ensure that if someone wants to donate a bench or anything, we need to be consistent in the areas surrounding it.
