Chairman Fred Jones called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Old Business

Complete Streets CIP

Chairman Jones stated that his committee had been discussing the Complete Streets CIP. The Crash Analysis map was presented. This would identify “hot spots” to determine the basis to select projects going into the next four or five years to showcase our performance measure for our Complete Streets Policy. This is the first step at that initiative.

Colin Moore, Grant and Resiliency Coordinator, stated that most of our hot spots are state routes. FDOT is looking at a signalization project at Atlantic Boulevard/Florida Boulevard/Mayport Road. There is a conceptual plan for Bay Street and Third Street and Atlantic and Third Street.

Megan George, Deputy Public Works Director, stated that the East Coast Greenway route should be completed by the East Greenway Summit in April, 2020.

Chairman Jones commented that First Street could be used for traffic calming demonstration project, including pedestrian islands, landscaping and marking onstreet parking locations. As Dover, Kohl & Partners goes through their process, they could include the vision for First Street. The goal is for the City to create a list of projects that could be prioritized and budgeted. He suggested a work session to determine what could be done in-house to show what is being done from a safety and active transportation standpoint. The projects should also be a connected network.

New Business

Penman Road Corridor Study

Mr. Moore provided a list of elements to potentially be included in the City of Jacksonville Penman Road Corridor Study. He suggested any additional feedback to add to the list from City staff.
